



Mayim is our signature elementary learning program (grades K-5) at Temple Beth Shalom. Through an experiential and project-based learning curriculum, it is a wonderful way for children to experience meaningful Jewish learning as they build relationships in our TBS community. There is rich learning that happens each year, and learning builds from one year to the next.

Mayim Tamid ("Mayim Always") is a multi-day afterschool program program which combines the childcare and enrichment programming found in many extended day programs with the rich Jewish learning and community building found in our Mayim program. 
